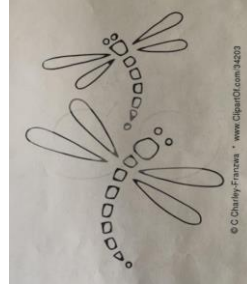
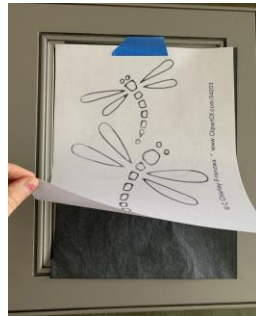


## Mosaic Tile Protocol

- 1) First, pick your mosaic template! You can find a variety of templates online by searching images through Google, Pinterest, and more.



- 2) After you have chosen your template, choose a frame you would like to put your mosaic design on.
  - a) Repurposed wooden frames are suggested. Tape your template to a sheet of graphite paper with the shiny side facing down on top of the surface you want to trace upon.
  - b) Taping more than one side of the paper to the frame is recommended to make sure the image is stable while you are tracing.



- 3) After you are finished tracing you will can use an inexpensive heat gun to cut simple shapes to be placed on top of your design. Hold heat gun approximately 3 inches from the disc, rotating for at least 20 seconds.



- 4) Depending on the chosen design, it may require the use of a ruler to center the design on the frame.

- 5) Once all the CD pieces are centered and placed on the frame you will apply tape across the entire design surface.
  - a) Flip the mosaic over and apply a drop of super glue to the back of individual CD pieces.
  - b) Caution: Super glue is an extremely binding adhesive. Read the label on the bottle before continuing this step and wait for instruction from the supervising therapist.
- 6) Once glue is applied to the back of all CD pieces, flip the design back over and place onto your chosen frame.
- 7) Pat design in place to increase binding of glue to the wooden frame. Slowly peel back the tape. You have successfully transferred your mosaic and now have the finished product!
